Description:

The Rainbow Youth Program Worker will work in collaboration with other facilitators to facilitate the Rainbow Youth Program (RYP). RYP aims to make 2SLGBTQIA+ youth feel safe, included, and empowered in Peterborough and the four counties. The RYP worker facilitates a weekly youth drop in for building connections and resilience. The worker also facilitates the queeRADicals, a youth ambassador group, to direct community outreach such as events, inclusivity trainings, and community partnerships.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Direct Youth Support & Engagement:

- Provide referrals and information for youth to other community resources
- Provide safer sex education

Group Facilitation:

- Co-facilitate weekly Rainbow Youth Drop-in (in-person and virtual)
- Co-facilitate queeRADicals meetings

Other:

- Comply with all PARN Policies and Procedures
- Engage in ongoing relevant education, training, and professional development opportunities provided by the agency;
- Perform other project-related tasks as assigned
